


Central Slovakia: Where Tradition Meets Innovation

Central Slovakia comprises two regions: Žilina Region (Žillinský kraj) and Banská Bystrica Region (Banskobystrický kraj), bordered by the Czech Republic, Poland, and Hungary.

The Žilina Region, with a total population of around 690 thousand inhabitants, holds significance as a key economic hub, with a developed industry providing enough working opportunities. Notably, around 51.3% of the population is actively engaged in economic activities. Well-connected internationally, Žilina Region serves as a vital transportation hub, linking Slovakia, the Czech Republic, and Poland. Žilina is considered one of Slovakia's automotive hubs, with the automotive plant KIA and several OEMs located in the area. Other key industries include metallurgy, mechanical engineering, electrotonics and wood and paper production.

The Banská Bystrica Region boasts a population of around 620 thousand inhabitants. The industry primarily focuses on manufacturing metals and metal products, producing other non-metallic mineral items, as well as producing food, beverages, machinery and equipment.



Road Network

The Žilina Region holds a strategically advantageous transport position within Slovakia, intersected by significant international and domestic roads. Key routes, including the one connecting the Czech Republic to Ukraine and the route from Bratislava and Šahy to Poland, traverse through this region.

Two motorways cross the Žilina Region, and some of their sections are currently under construction: the D1 from Bratislava to Košice and the D3 from Hričovské Podhradie to Žilina, continuing on to Čadca and Poland.


The R1 expressway connects Banská Bystrica with the western part of Slovakia. Presently, a continuous section between Trnava and the bypass of Banská Bystrica is operational, with plans for extension to Ružomberok upon completion.

Motorways under construction

D1 Lietavská Lúčka - Dubná Skala: Currently under construction, the 13 km-long D1 motorway section including the currently longest tunnel Višňové will create a convenient connection between Žilina and Martin, allowing motorists to save up to 15 minutes of driving time.

D1 Hubová - Ivachnová: The D1 Hubová - Ivachnová section, spanning over 14 kilometers, will serve as a bypass for the town of Ružomberok, resulting in a time savings of 16 minutes.

R2 Kriváň - Mýtna: Upon completion of the 9-km-long R2 expressway section, motorists will enjoy a secure motorway link from Bratislava to Lučenec, excluding the Zvolen, West - Zvolen, East section.





Center of gravity for national logistics

CTPark Banská Bystrica is strategically positioned in central Slovakia, benefiting from excellent connectivity to the adjacent R1 expressway. The region boasts several strengths, including an abundant workforce, a high level of education in regional centers, and a large base of raw materials that support various sectors, notably metallurgy, glass processing, and the chemical industry. Upon its completion, CTPark Banská Bystrica will offer ca. 17,000 sqm of A-class warehouse and production space suitable for logistics, distribution and production.








Slovakia's hub for raw materials



CTPark Žilina Airport is situated right in the heart of one of Slovakia's main automotive and high-tech clusters. Kia Motors is located in Žilina, VW plants are just 30 km away in Martin, along with several other OEMs in the area. The park is strategically located on the E50/D1 motorway, with excellent access to the Czech Republic (40 km) and Poland (50 km).


















Next-generation manufacturing



Stable & well-established industrial zone


CTPark Žilina enjoys a highly advantageous location near an important international road junction. In the city of Žilina, three major roads of international significance, namely E50, E75, and E442, converge. The D1 motorway, which runs through Žilina, connects the city with Slovakia's capital, Bratislava (210 km), in the west, and with Košice (260 km) in the east.



Region with strong industrial tradition






