

Schortens: Strategic Naval Hub and Gateway to the Wadden Sea

The city of Schortens is an independent municipality in the Friesland district of Lower Saxony and the second-largest city in the district after Varel. Located directly on the Jade Bight, the neighboring city of Wilhelmshaven has been a naval base since the 1870s and remains the largest and most significant naval site in Germany, as well as the largest Bundeswehr base. Through continuous investments in infrastructure and facilities, the Bundeswehr serves as an important client for the regional economy. In addition to its significance for the navy, the city's proximity to the Wadden Sea makes it a popular travel destination year after year.

Strategically Located: Excellent Connectivity to Key Transport Hubs The property in Schortens is located 5 km west of Wilhelmshaven. With direct access to the B210 and the A29 just a few minutes away by car, cities like Oldenburg (52 km) and Bremen (90 km) as well as the Jade-Weser-Port—Germany's only deep-water port—are easily accessible. The nearest airport is located in Bremen. A nearby bus stop provides a convenient connection to Wilhelmshaven's main train station, which can be reached in approximately 30 minutes.




